Details-

On 29 January 2024, some of our departmental students went for an educational trip to Santiniketan, Bolpur. The students were accompanied by all the teachers of the Department of Philosophy, Prof. Totan Hazra, Prof. Nanda Dulal Mahato, Prof.(Dr.) Koyel Koley, Smt. Moumita Banerjee, Sri Subrata Mandal, Sri Arunava Das and Miss Suchitra Das.

Educational trip not only enhance the knowledge of the students but also their outlook towards the outside world. The students developed a love for nature and reinforced their creative facilities when they got a chance to visit the land of Rabindranath Tagore, Santiniketan. The students also visited Patha Bhavana and were enthralled by the idea of an open-air school.

The students visited the museum inside the Uttarayan complex where they were enriched with the most abundant collection of Tagore's paintings, Tagore's family tree with the museum showcasing some of his popular and rare pieces. It is the only place where one can lay his hands to prints of Tagore's paintings, the museum office also has stocks on some of his calligraphy prints.

The tour also includes a visit to an important part of Visva-Bharati University, Rabindra Bhavana, where the museum house in the Bhavana, comprising of a permanent display section and the five homes lived in by Tagore, collectively referred to as the Uttarayan complex.

The audio-visual archives hold voice recording of Rabindranath Tagore in wire, tape and disc.

Round about 1.30 p.m we all went a resturant named 'Apanjan' and have our lunch. Both the students and the Teachers where relished with a good quality food and a good atmosphere at restaurant.

After having our lunch we all visited the central library and met with Dr. Nimai Chandra Saha and other librarians. Dr. Sujit Kujur and Dr. Kaushik Ghosh. Dr. Saha delivered a great and in formative discussion on library science. The students got the

knowledge of open access system of the Visva- Bharati University library. Both the students and the Teachers gathered the information on how to handle books in library, how to selfaccess books in library. Both the teachers and the students also visited the Braille unit of the

library and gathered the knowledge about Braille system in library.

After a long day run the trip came to the end. After visiting library we travel to the

station on Toto and then within a short time the train arrived to the Bolpur station, we all got

in to the train and this ends our one day educational trip to Shantiniketan, the place of

Rabindranath Tagore.

The students got the knowledge that learning is a part of life, which can be obtained
