(b) For candidates who passed HS (10+2) level or equivalent examination in 2021/2022/2023/2024 are eligible for application in first semester UG Programmes.

(c) For candidates who passed in HS(10+2) level or equivalent examination in **vocational Business & Commerce**, can apply for admission in 4-year B.Com (Hons.) in Accountancy/Finance (major) or 3-year B.A./B.Sc. UG Programmes.

(d) For candidates who passed in HS(10+2) level or equivalent examination in **vocational engineering & technology (with pass marks in Mathematics)**, can apply for admission in 3-year B.A./B.Sc. UG Programmes.

(e) For candidates who passed in HS (10+2) level or equivalent examination in **vocational agriculture**, can apply for admission in 3-year B.A./B.Sc. UG Programmes.

(f) For candidates who passed in HS (10+2) level or equivalent examination in **vocational home science**, can apply for admission in 3-year B.A. UG Programmes.
